

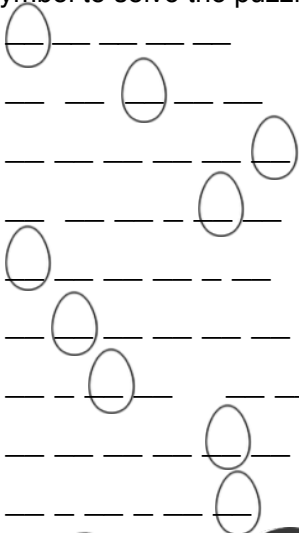

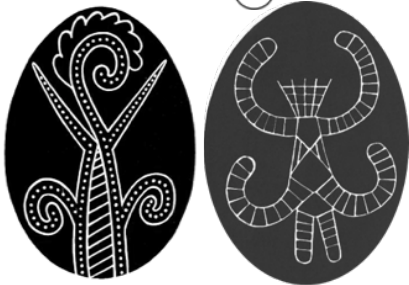

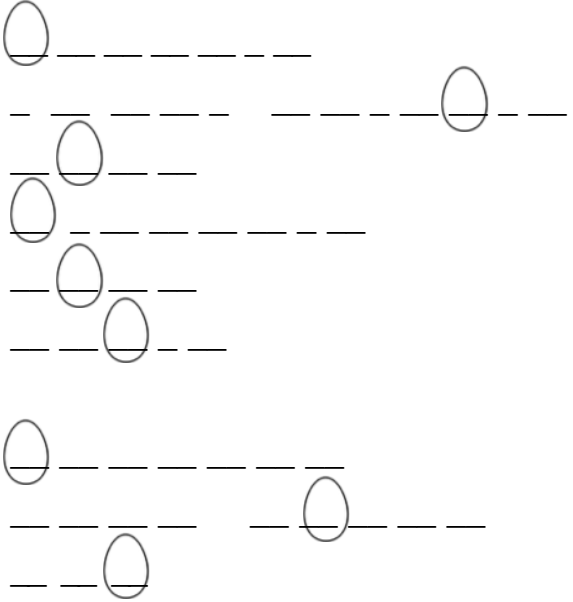


1. A wish coming true, the anticipation of spring, and new beginnings.

WHAT'S THE NAME OF ONE OF THE OLDEST SYMBOLS IN PYSANKY. _____

This symbol was believed to be the name of a goddess that protected the home and preserved the family. It was also believed that this goddess was the creator of all living things and the controller of all destinies. Sometimes this symbol can be in a more abstract form and resemble flowers or a tree and is represented by a plant. When this symbol is represented by a plant it is called a vazon, or the Tree of Life.
