

Canada Paragraph Examples (Location)

As part of your country project, you will need to write paragraphs using the information that you researched. Remember to use the following guide to help you write a paragraph:

- Opening Statement: state the main idea of the paragraph with a tell. YELL! or Question?
- Supporting Detail: write your researched information in a few sentences. You can combine some of the information into one sentence, but you will definitely need to write at least two sentences of supporting detail for each paragraph.
- Closing Statement: restate the main idea of the paragraph with tell. YELL! Or Question?

*** Please remember that a paragraph is more interesting when you add more detail. ***

Using the information about Canada's location, I have written three different examples of a country paragraph for you. Please note that I have included all of the information about Canada's location, and used a tell YELL! & Question for the opening and closing statements.

Here's an example of a paragraph using an opening and closing statement with a tell.

Canada is located in North America. Canada is between 42 degrees North and 83 degrees North. With lines of longitude, Canada can be found between 53 degrees West and 141 degrees West. Canada touches three oceans (Pacific, Atlantic, and Arctic), two big bays (Hudson and Baffin) and the Great Lakes with the USA. Canada borders the United States of America and Greenland which is owned by Denmark. You will find Canada in the northern and western hemispheres, and it reaches close to the North Pole. Canada has an interesting location.

Here's an example of a paragraph using an opening and closing statement with a YELL!

Canada is the top country in North America! It is located in both the northern and western hemispheres, and it reaches close to the North Pole. Canada is located between 42 degrees North and 83 degrees North, as well as between 53 degrees West and 141 degrees West. Canada is a neighbouring country to the United States and Denmark (Greenland) and is surrounded by water. In fact, Canada touches three oceans (Pacific, Atlantic, and Arctic), the Great Lakes, and two big bays (Hudson and Baffin). Canada is quite unique with its location!

Here's an example of a paragraph using an opening and closing statement with a question?

Did you know that Canada reaches close to the North Pole and touches three oceans? Canada is surrounded by water like the Pacific, Atlantic, and Arctic Oceans, as well as the Great Lakes and Hudson Bay. Canada is also located near the United States and Greenland, which is governed by Denmark. If you were to look for Canada using coordinates, you would find Canada in the northern hemisphere between 42 degrees and 83 degrees, and in the western hemisphere between 53 degrees and 141 degrees. Can you think of another country that is as unique as Canada with its location?
