

Country Research Categories

WHITE RESEARCH CHART PAPER

For each of the categories below, you need to research at least 3 interesting pieces of information and write it onto your white research chart. **Here are some suggested questions that you may want to research for each category.**

1. Climate: What are the main seasons and when are they?

Remember that in the southern hemisphere, the seasons are reversed compared to the northern hemisphere. Also remember that countries located in the tropics don't have four seasons.

Does your country have a rainy or dry season? If so, when are they (what months)?

2. Foods and Drinks: What food is typically grown, raised or caught?
What are some special foods and drinks?

3. Languages: What languages are spoken?
What are some examples of words used?
What are some common slang words or expressions?
How do you say hello, good-bye, please and thank you?

Religion/Leisure: What are the main religions?
What are the special holidays?
When are the holidays?
What do people do during their free time?
What are some popular sports?

Flag: Describe the flag (ie. colours, design, symbols, lines/bars, etc.)
What do the symbols and colours on the flag represent?
When was the flag created?

Individual Inquiry: What else are you wondering about?
What other questions do you have about your country?
In this category, write down three things that you are wondering about with your country. Write down the questions, and then answer them on the white chart paper.

The above questions in each category are just suggestions. You can research any interesting information for each section, but remember you need to record at least 3 pieces of information for each category. The more information you find, the more interesting your report will become for you and your curious teacher.
